Established on 18 June 1908 by Act No. 1870 of the First Philippine Legislature, UP was officially designated as the national university in 2009 during its centennial year through Republic Act No. 9500, the UP Charter of 2008.

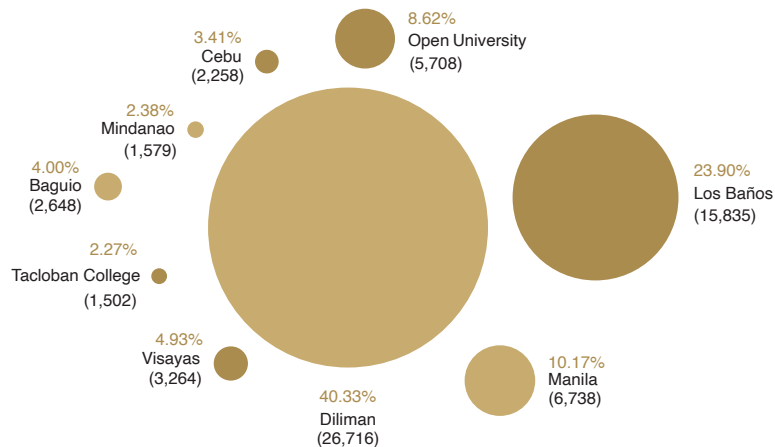


From a single campus in Manila with seven colleges, UP has expanded into a system of eight constituent universities and one autonomous college across 23 campuses nationwide.

Enrollment Distribution by Constituent University, A.Y. 2024–2025

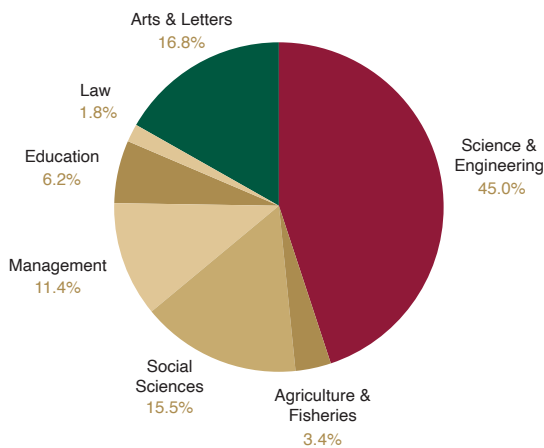

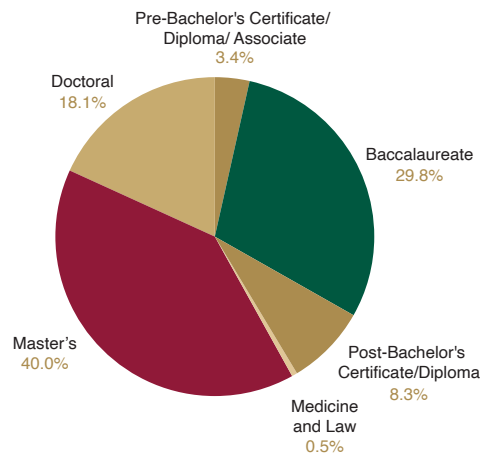
